Classification of the Diabetic Foot Syndrome

The Diabetic Foot Syndrome (DFS) results from diabetes mellitus and involves a whole series of various symptoms. The cause of a diabetic foot syndrome can be either a neuropathic or an ischaemic foot, or a combination of both.

If it is the former, the nerves are damaged because of a permanently heightened blood glucose level which is weakening the muscles and causing the ligamentous apparatus to collapse.

Diabetic patients experience symptoms such as, for example, numbness, pressure points on the foot's sole and/or the toes as well as dry and vulnerable skin. Manifesting ulcers can become chronic wounds which only heal poorly, if at all.

In the case of an ischaemic foot, the arterial blood flow is interrupted. This may lead to the death of entire tissue areas.

Generally, wound treatment is an essential part of DFS therapy as the wounds' ability to heal is often impaired. This may result in amputations of the extremities after incorrect weight-bearing on the foot.

The cause of DFS must be considered when treating diabetic feet as each therapy differs from the other in many ways or is even contraindicated.

Moreover, the correct assessment of the existent risk group is essential for avoiding (further) injuries and to ensure the proper treatment of each individual patient.

In this catalogue you will find DIABETES therapeutic shoes for risk groups II, III and VII. You can see which risk groups and wound stages each DIABETES therapeutic shoe is especially recommended for in the product information in the paragraph Indications (for diabetes) on each shoe page. Our specifications are based on the classifications below.

Risk Groups of the Diabetic Foot Syndrome*

Shoe Treatment

Risk groups II and III

For the treatment of diabetes mellitus with sensory neuropathy caused by PNP/relevant PAD and/or a condition after a plantar ulcer, usually, a therapeutic shoe with a custom-made foot orthotic or an orthopaedic shoe modification is used. That is why we offer an insole blank or insole set for all DIABETES therapeutic shoes, which can be adapted to relieve plantar pressure points. The insole can be used as a temporary measure until the patient-specific, custom-made foot bed has been made. In addition, the DIABETES therapeutic shoes offer sufficient space to allow a thick insole/foot orthotic to be used, without constricting the foot. Should more space be required due to bandages, foot malpositions/deformities or others, the inner volume can be adjusted, a wider shoe version can be selected or the (inner) material can be further modified.

Risk group VII

Recommended therapeutic shoes for lesions usually are relief, bandage, interim and orthosis shoes with a diabetic foot orthotic or an orthopaedic shoe modification. The shoes we offer for this treatment - especially the WIDE version - provide sufficient space for an individual foot orthotic as well as for additional bandages and/or orthoses that the patient wears. Due to the hook and loop fasteners, the wide shoe versions and the adaptable (inner) material, the shoes can also provide targeted relief in non-plantar areas. Additionally, the rigid sole design and the tall shaft ensure stability and security during stance and gait.

Dear Customer,

We measured our therapeutic shoes according to the Mondopoint system. Afterwards, the shoe sizes were recalculated by means of the Paris Point.

Mondopoint System

The Mondopoint system is an international standardised system to indicate shoe sizes. In contrast to other systems, not only the inner shoe length but also the inner shoe width is measured.

Paris Point

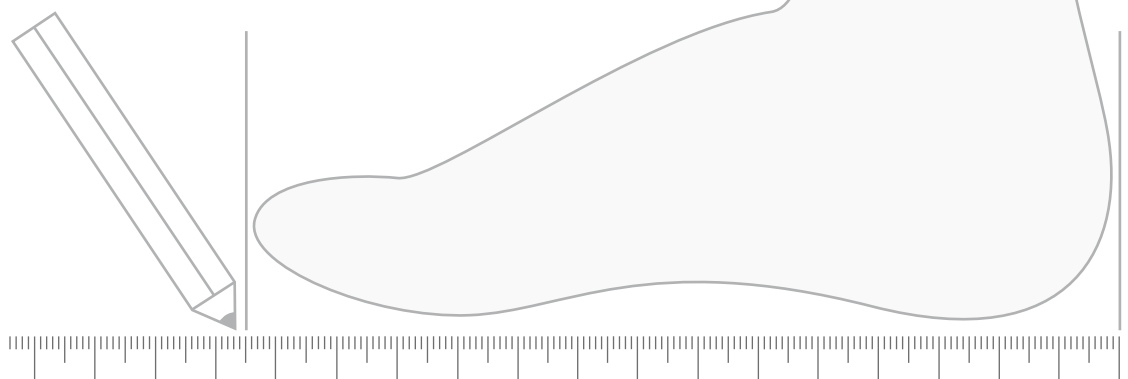
To determine the shoe sizes we used the Paris Point which is calculated as follows:

$$(\text{foot length} + 1.5\text{cm}) \times 1.5$$

Length and width are indicated in mm.

ATTENTION!

In this catalogue, we state outdoor shoe sizes. These shoe sizes do not cover additional space for bandages or the like.



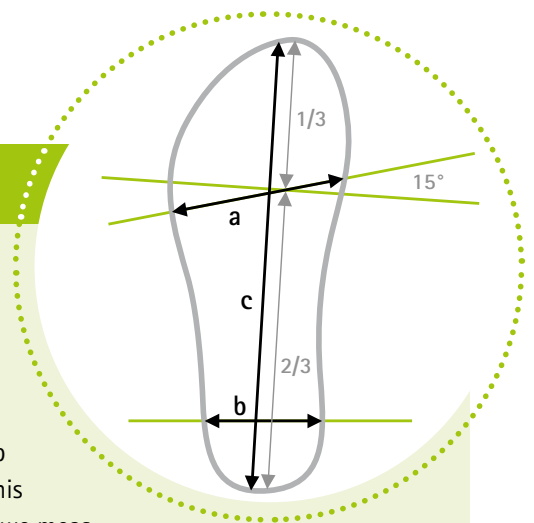
Asymmetric Shoes

Inner shoe length

The inner shoe length (c) was measured from the middle of the heel area to the middle of the great toe with a standard measurement device.

Inner shoe widths (ball and heel area)

The inner shoe widths were measured at the insole. We measured from the toe-cap and drew a crossline at 1/3 of the insole for the inner shoe width in ball area. At this right-angled straight line a 15° angle was measured. The resulting line was where we measured the inner shoe width in ball area (a). The inner shoe width in heel area (b) was measured at the level of the middle of the heel.

The integrated elastic textile material as well as two removable insoles offer a flexible volume. Furthermore, it is possible to create an outsole elevation with an EVA sheet or to attach a vibram® flat sole under the shoe for additional slip resistance. CROSSROADS is available in four different combinations of REGULAR and SLIM widths. This makes the fit ideal for any foot – with and without an orthosis.

INDOORS & OUTDOORS

WASHABLE

All therapeutic shoes can be washed at 40°C.

All HOMECARE therapeutic shoes are also suitable for both indoor and outdoor activities.

BREATHABLE

The upper fabric of all therapeutic shoes is breathable.

OUTSOLES

Most outsoles are 30mm thick and are made of EVA solid material and rubber. The rigid soles of the DIABETES and POST-OP therapeutic shoes can be adapted to patient-specific needs by grinding the sole base and/or gluing. In addition, the design of the POST-OP therapeutic shoes prevent flexion of the metatarsophalangeal joints and ensures the patient's foot being stabilised and immobilised. That is how an existing wound is relieved and the wound's healing supported in an optimal way.

The soles of the HOMECARE therapeutic shoes are flexible and have a slight wedge heel. This sole design supports a natural heel to toe movement while walking.

REINFORCED HEEL CAP

All therapeutic shoes with a closed heel area are equipped with a reinforced heel cap which provides support for the patient, cushions the heel and ensures comfortable stability.

FASTENER SYSTEM

Many therapeutic shoes can be opened and closed easily due to the hook and loop fasteners. Generous loop areas on the shoe ensure individual wearing comfort. Furthermore, the hook and loop fasteners have additional seams, allowing them to be shortened as needed.

ADAPTABLE INNER VOLUME

Using the adjustable hook and loop fasteners or spacious hook and instep fasteners and the removable insoles, the inner volume can be adapted to the individual need for space of a patient.

INSOLES

Many therapeutic shoe models have EVA insoles, of which the upper insole has an antimicrobial coating. By modifying the insoles, the inner volume and the hardness of the padding can be adapted to individual space and wear requirements. If applicable, the insoles can be replaced with an individual foot orthotic.
